#### ANNEX 7

### TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR HOST NATION SUPPORT (HNS) CELL

HNS cell represents the direct link between the Local Emergency Management Agency (LEMA) and the international teams for the duration of their mission in the country and is designed to:

- ensure the better use of the capabilities of the teams from their arrival;
- integrate teams' operations with the ongoing response effort;
- support the teams in all logistic needs including fuel, transport, food and
- assist the teams in all contacts/relations with population and/or administrations;
- facilitate the liaison between the teams and local/national operational centres.

HNS cell has to be considered apart from the local incident commander and it is not responsible for:

- operational coordination of the team;
  - technical advise during the rescue/relief operations

#### 1. Timetable

	Stages	Date and time or indicative period
a)	Publication of the call	27/02/2019
b)	Deadline for submitting applications	15/05/2019 - 17:00 CET
c)	Evaluation period	June - July 2019
d)	Information to applicants	July - September 2019
e)	Signature of Grant Agreements	September - November 2019
f)	Starting date of the actions	1 January 2020





#### 2. Budget

The total available budget is EUR 4 000 000.

This budget is divided between

- Internal budget item: EUR 3 000 000 for exercises benefitting Participating States in the UCPM.
- External budget item: EUR 1 000 000 for exercises covering:
- **IPA II** beneficiaries not participating in the mechanism: Albania, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Kosovo11.
- European Neighbourhood Policy countries: Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Moldova and Ukraine.
- Algeria, Egypt, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Palestine and Tunisia.





- The EU contribution per exercise project is limited to a maximum of EUR 1 000 000.
- The EU co-funding rate in the framework of this Call amounts up to 85% of the total eligible costs per exercise project.
- The beneficiaries need to guarantee that the **remaining 15%** of the total eligible cost per exercise project come from sources other than the EU grant. The applicants are thus encouraged to look for other possible local, national or international, private and public sources other than the Union.
- Maximum project duration: 24 months (extensions will be possible only exceptionally, for duly justified reasons and with our agreement).





#### 3. Award criteria

The award criteria are divided into four dimensions. The total amount of points a proposal can get is **100** of which **63** points is the minimum threshold.

Admissible and eligible applications will be evaluated and ranked against of the following award criteria:

- Relevant elements of the exercise project: max 25 points with a threshold of 15
- Methodology: max 30 points with a threshold of 20
- Cost effectiveness: max 15 points with a threshold of 8
- European dimension: max 30 points with a threshold of 20





- Applications must be submitted electronically via the Participant Portal Electronic Submission System and using the forms provided.
- Paper submissions are no longer possible.




