This is an invitation to submit proposals for EU action grants in the field of disaster risk management under the Union Civil Protection Mechanism. (UCPM)

The work programme¹ of the UCPM for 2021-2025 provides for a funding opportunity to directly support Member States' efforts in the field of disaster risk management (Action 2.1.2, Technical Assistance for Disaster Risk Management grants).

The purpose of this action is to help national civil protection and other disaster risk management authorities fill technical and/or financial gaps to preparing investments or to strengthening their institutional and policy framework for disaster risk management.

The enclosed Annex specifies the conditions for awarding these grants, including the exclusion, selection and award criteria. Please note that these are single-country (monobeneficiary) grants.

This letter does not prejudge the Commission's final decision on your request.

The rules determining the grant award procedures are set out in the Financial Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 18 July 2018 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union (OJ L 193, 30.7.2018, p.1).
