## Background

- **Capitalizing** the results of **EASeR project** on «**barrier effect**» in assessment and **taking** advantage of it
- **Enhancing** the **training site of Poggioreale**, Sicily, hit by an earthquake in 1968
- **Taking the opportunity** of Italian chairing AEME Group of INSARAG Secretariat to present **results on USAR assessment** (procedures and training)



## & Objectives

- **providing a methodology and training to perform the initial wide assessment (ASR1) as INSARAG Guidelines/training (i.e. First Responders Training) does not cover specifically this aspect of emergency intervention.**
- bringing together operational (USAR teams) and non-operational actors (LLAA, disaster managers) who will be trained on a standard methodology (mirrored in a Manual of ASR1).**

# Methodology



- ❑ The involvement of **Top Senior Experts (Board of Experts)** to produce a **Manual of ASR1** in EN and in three additional languages: IT, FR, DE.  
that will be operational and simply to consult and apply
- ❑ targets **operational and non-operational actors** as a whole
- ❑ starts from **training the trainers** (1 Pilot training course) that will carry out 4 training field courses
- ❑ **coaching** the trainers (by the Board) during 4 field courses
- ❑ design, develop, apply and finalise a **Handbook for trainers on ASR1** that will be translated into 3 languages (IT, FR, DE) to be easily spread
- ❑ **evaluate** the 5 training courses (Pilot ToT, Field Training Courses) to improve step by step and mitigate problems.
- ❑ the real scenario of **Poggioreale, Sicily** as **added value**



## Outcomes & Target Groups (short term)

- ❑ **OUTCOME 1:** a methodology to perform ASR1 is available and applied by operational and non-operational actors;
- ❑ **OUTCOME 2:** involved trainees from USAR teams, CP authorities, disaster managers are able to carry out an operational plan during ASR1;
- ❑ **OUTCOME 3:** the training area of Poggioreale becomes a referent site exploited at EU level to train USAR teams.
- ❑ **Teams (directly trained):** have a manual to perform the wide assessment (ASR1) and acquire knowledge to apply it through indoor/outdoor field training; are prepared to face challenges in ASR1.
- ❑ **CP National Authorities:** use, spread, apply the Manual at national, regional and local level; in some cases also at international level (Chair of Regional AEME of INSARAG); are trained on how to perform ASR1 and learn about operational challenges.
- ❑ **Disaster Managers:** learn about ASR1 and improve their capability to manage priorities and resources.
- ❑ **Trainers:** through a cascading system disseminate, apply and use the Handbook for trainers on ASR1
