1. Building evacuation preparedness

- To create standards for setting up an evacuation center
- To create standards for joint operations to enhance harmonised cross-border approaches

2. Training staff and volunteers

- To improve response capacities and cooperation with authorities in mass evacuations by creating training packages, organising workshops and training events for staff and volunteers

3. Exercising and testing interoperability of established capacities

- To exercise and test of interoperability of established capacities
