3.1. Administrative info

Assessment round 1

- b) Description of the humanitarian aid interventions relating to this assessment round: Interventions will have to address the needs and be in line with DG ECHO proposed response as described in section 3, and in particular section 3.2, of the HIP.
- c) Costs will be eligible from 01/ 01/2018. Actions will start from 01/01/2018
- d) The duration for the Action is up to 12 months.
- e) Potential partners²: Open to all ECHO partners
- f) Information to be provided: Single Form
- g) Indicative date for receipt of the above requested information: by 28/02/2018 at the latest

3.2. Operational requirements:

3.2.1. Assessment criteria:

The assessment of proposals will look at:

- The compliance with the proposed strategy (HIP) and the operational requirements described in this section;
- Commonly used principles such as: quality of the needs assessment and of the logical framework, relevance of the intervention and coverage, feasibility, applicant's implementation capacity and knowledge of the sector of intervention.
