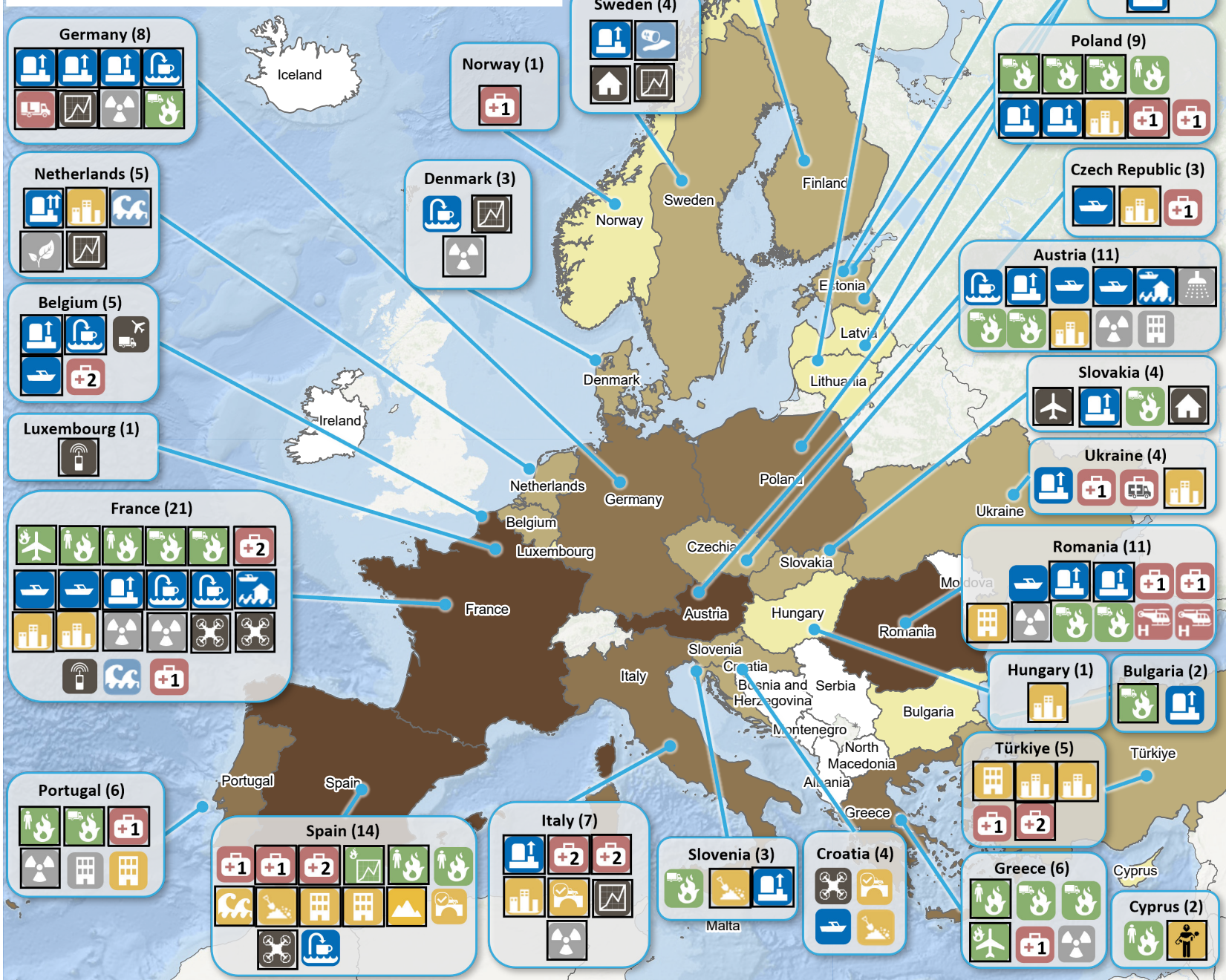


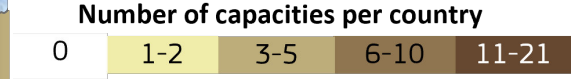

Since the establishment of the pool in October 2014, 28 countries have brought together 147 civil protection capacities which are now available (or will eventually become available) for EU operations worldwide.
